

Bibliography of Books About Cape Ann

This is a first draft of the index to the **BIBLIOGRAPHY OF CAPE ANN LITERATURE**, compiled by Robert Brown in 1965 and updated by Gregory Gibson in 1978. It contains citations of the thousands of books, maps, monographs, pamphlets and periodicals that deal with the history of Gloucester, Rockport, Essex and Manchester-by-the-Sea.

Many of the listings have a capital letter at the end. This is the "Location Symbol" of the library in which the cited copy was found in 1977-78.
